# Make an Impact Through Giving: Generosity Sunday a.m. 4/15/2018

- ❖ We are continuing our series entitled Make an Impact Through Giving
- ❖ We will see what God's word teaches us about money and stewardship
- Last week, we talked about this fact: God owns it all!
- ♣ Today, we will talk about Generosity
  - We will look today at giving through this question: What happens when we give?

#### John 6:5-13

- ❖ Jesus fed 5,000 people with a boy's 2 fish and 5 loafs of bread
  - > Let's see What happens when we give?
- We Honor God when We Give
  - Remember, God owns it all
- ❖ The boy honored Jesus when he gave his lunch to Jesus
- ❖ The Bible tells us to give first to God's work through the local church
- > Why does God ask us to give our tithe to His Church?
  - He knows that our hearts are connected to our treasure

# Matthew 6:19-21 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup> "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; <sup>20</sup> but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

- ♣ This is why we spend so much money on our children...we love them
- ♣ They are our treasure, so that is where our heart is
- ♣ We wanted our children to be involved in school activities, church events
- ♣ There were times we had to cut back so they could be involved

- O Your heart is there, so you can't stop thinking about it
- ♦ When you give to God's Work, it automatically connects your heart to God's Work!
- The boy honored Jesus by giving up his lunch of 5 loaves and 2 fish and it connected the boy to the miracle Jesus performed
- God has a plan for financing His work since He calls us to do His work
- ❖ The biblical standard is to give 10%, a tithe, of our income to God
- Giving 10 percent can seem impossible when bills need to be paid
- ❖ I started tithing with my first job when I was 16 and have continued

## Malachi 3:10a (NKJV)

Bring all the tithes into the storehouse that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this,"

- The principle of tithing is the foundation of giving
  - Abram gave Melchizedek 10% of the spoils of a battle (Genesis 14)
  - ♣ 10% was required to support priests, Levites, poor and widows
  - ♣ Tithing in the Old Testament supported God's work for Israel
  - Jesus said that He came to full fill the law

## Matthew 5:17 (NKJV)

"Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill.

- That includes tithing
- What is the storehouse?
- ✓ A "savings account" that took care of the priests, Levites, poor, widows
- Is the N.T church equivalent to the O.T. storehouse?
- ❖ The church is not the temple or Israel, but it is a model for the church
- Tithing supports the needs and ministries of the church

#### 2017

Budget \$893,427.00
Received \$862,645.14
Spent \$878,576.87

- ✓ We were **\$15,931.73** in the hole and **\$30,781.86** below budget
- **☼** Total giving last year was \$77,770.66 above budget
- Many give to a designated item and not to the budget
- Designated offerings cause the budget of the church to suffer
  - ☼ Imagine that when you receive your pay check that it is designated only to your house payment, electric bill and food
- ❖ We asked you last year to give to over 15 individual causes
- > We could do more, give more in a joint effort through the budget
  - ☼ Imagine, your giving to the budget would enable a child to go to summer camp for free
  - ☼ Imagine, giving more to missions than we have ever given because giving is not limited to the few that give to missions
- √ 2% of budget offering goes to Live2Serve
- ✓ Lottie Moon offering averages \$5,000 \$6,00, imagine \$10,000
  - ♣ We will limit the number of specific causes for you to give to this year
- > We are asking you to only give to the budget
  - This is our first year to ask you to do this, so please be patient as we start this process and we welcome your questions
- > Remember, we honor God when we give
- We Bless Others When We Give
- We are called to help people in great need

- ♣ We are compelled and called to serve others
  - Jesus saw the need and was compelled to feed them
- ❖ Because the boy gave his bread and fish, 5,000 people ate until they were full and witnessed a miracle!
- That little boy blessed others!
- We see generosity that blesses others throughout the Bible

### Acts 4:34-35 (NKJV)

34 Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, 35 and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.

- Generosity blesses others!
- ❖ Have you ever received a gift that has blessed you? How did you feel?
  - People know that I enjoy history
  - Occasionally, someone will give me a book or a piece of history that really makes me fill blessed
- Giving to Morris Hill Baptist and God's Work enables you to bless others
- We have been able to bless others by helping with utility bills, food, etc.
- **VBS** is around the corner and your giving makes VBS possible
  - **♥ VBS** is our largest evangelistic event
- > Your giving blesses others
- We are Blessed When We Give
- When we give to His work, we will be blessed

- ♦ How do you feel when children walk down the aisle and say they trusted Christ as their Savior in VBS
- That was because you gave to the budget of Morris Hill Baptist
  - **○** Do you think that boy was blessed to see Jesus use his lunch to feed 5,000 men that gathered to Hear Jesus?
- ❖ Let's go back to Malachi 3:10
- ❖ This is the only time God says, "Test Me"
- ❖ Now look at Malachi 3:10b-12
  - He will pour out more blessings than we can handle
  - He tells Israel that nations will call them blessed
- **②** Would you ever say, "it's just not worth it to give to God"?
- When you give to Morris Hill Baptist, your money goes around the world
- ♣ I feel blessed because Beth and I, now our children, faithfully give to the work of God through His church
- ♣ Sometimes, I hear stories of how God uses the money we have given, but more often, I will only hear those stories in Heaven
- ✓ Bill Borden was an outstanding young leader and athlete at Yale
- ✓ He inherited well over a million dollars when his father died
- ✓ He was heir to the famous Borden Dairy Products family.
- √ In today's currency that would probably be over \$100 million
- ✓ He became a Christian as a young man and felt an increasing sense of call as a missionary to Muslims in China
- ✓ He wasn't married and lived an unpretentious lifestyle, so he said, "I don't need much money on the mission field."

- ✓ He made a will before he left for China
- He gave everything away. He gave it all away!
- \$100,000 went to National Bible Institute
- \$100,000 to Moody Bible Institute in Chicago.
- \$250,000 to the China Inland Mission, with \$100,000 to be invested and the interest used for a retirement fund for missionaries.
- He gave more to other Christ-centered causes
- ✓ Bill Borden arrived in Cairo, Egypt where he would learn Arabic
- √ He died from spinal meningitis a few months later
- ✓ He was 25 years old
- ✓ Most people in this world, would conclude, "What a waste!"
- ✓ Three phrases were found written inside his Bible: "No reserves. No retreats. No regrets."
  - Bill Borden understood what generosity was all about
